Unit 5: Numéro vacances (Holidays)

Overview:

- Talk about holidays and accommodation.
- Talk about your ideal holiday.
- Discuss what you can see/do on holiday.
- Give advice and make recommendations.
- Talk about festivals.
- Review and book holiday accommodation.
- Talk about staycation activities.

Skills and grammar:

- Be able to say what you would like to do using *je voudrais/j'aimerais*
- Be able to use *pour* + infinitive.
- Be able to recognise the conditional tense.
- Be able to give reasons for your preferences.
- Be able to form different types of questions.
- Be able to use *il faut, on peut* and *on doit* correctly.
- Be able to use relative clauses.
- Be able to identify positive and negative opinions.
- Be able to use the perfect tense of modal verbs.
- Be able to use the negative in past tenses.
- Be able to use *si* + the present and near future tenses.

Unit 6: Notre planète (Our Planet)

Overview:

- Understand key facts about the environment.
- Talk about geography and the climate.
- Learn about francophone countries.
- Talk about environmental problems.
- Talk about future weather.
- Discuss how we can work together to protect the environment.
- Talk about day-to-day actions to protect the environment.
- Discuss school environmental projects.

- Talk about new technologies.

Skills and grammar:

- Be able to use numbers and percentages.
- Be able to use comparatives and superlatives.
- Be able to understand the present tense of the passive voice.
- Be able to recognise/use the *nous*-form imperative.
- Be able to use the imperfect tense to describe what you used to do.
- Be able to understand when to use the perfect and the imperfect tenses.
- Be able to use *en* + the present participles.
- Be able to use *venir de* and *être en train de*.
- Be able to express opinions in a variety of ways.
- Be able to extend written and spoken answers.
- Be able to answer questions using a variety of tenses.

Unit 7: Mon petit monde à moi (Where I live)

Overview:

- Understand adverts.
- Describe your town or village.
- Ask for and understand directions.
- Talk about shopping for clothes.
- Practise shopping role plays.
- Describe your ideal home.
- Talk about visiting another town or city.

Skills and grammar:

- Be able to use demonstrative adjectives (*ce, cet, cette, ces*).
- Be able to use the pronoun *y*.
- Be able to translate phrases with *depuis*.
- Be able to use the correct translation for 'in'.
- Be able to work out if adjectives go before or after the noun.
- Be able to use *à* and *de* with the definite article.
- Be able to use *de* to demonstrate possession.
- Be able to use *si* clauses.
- Be able to work out the meaning of unfamiliar words.
- Be able to transcribe unfamiliar words.
- Be able to translate questions in different tenses.
- Be able to spot different tenses from verb endings.

Unit 8: Mes projets d'avenir (Future Plans)

Overview:

- Describe your plans for summer.
- Talk about future plans and hopes.
- Talk about travelling and earning money.
- Buy tickets at a train station.
- Talk about possible future career paths.
- Talk about different jobs.

Skill and grammar:

- Be able to use two-three different tenses to express the future.
- Be able to use sequencers effectively.
- Be able to use a range of structures followed by the infinitive.
- Be able to use infinitives as nouns.
- Be able to use verbs that take *être* in the perfect tense.
- Be able to use verbs followed by *à* or *de*.
- Be able to translate into French using a range of time frames.
- Be able to translate more complex structures.
