Unit 1: My Family Life

Overview:

- Revise talking about yourself
- Say how many siblings you have
- Describe your family and pets
- Use nos. 1-100 to describe ages
- Describe your looks/personality
- Describe your house and where you live

Skills and grammar:

- Recall phonics from Year 7.
- Be able to use higher numbers.
- Be able to use the possessive adjectives 'my' and 'your'.
- Be able to use the verbs *avoir* and *être*.
- Be able to use adjectives correctly.
- Be able to use *Il y a / il n'y a pas de*

Unit 2: In Town

Overview:

- Describe places of interest
- Say where you go at the weekend
- Invite someone out
- Order drinks and snacks in a cafe
- Describe what you are going to do next weekend
- Learn about famous places in Paris

Skills and grammar:

- Be able to identify prices in French.
- Be able to use the verb *aller* (to go) - (*je/il/elle/on* form)
- Be able to use the verb *vouloir* (to want) - (*je/il/elle/on* form)
- Be able to use the *tu* and *vous* forms of the verb.
- Be able to use the near future tense (*aller* + infinitive).
- Be able to use two tenses together.

Unit 3: Holidays

Overview:

- Describe holiday time in the French-speaking world.
- Learn about places to see in Geneva.
- Describe where you went on holiday, who with and what it was like.
- Describe which country you went to and how you travelled.
- Say what you did on holiday.
- Describe a visit to a theme park.

Skills and grammar:

- Revisit the verbs *avoir* and *être*.
- Be able to use the perfect tense of regular –er verbs.
- Be able to use the perfect tense of irregular verbs.
- Be able to use the perfect tense of verbs that take *être*.
- Be able to ask and answer questions.
- Be able to use the present and perfect tenses together.
